of Evolved Expendable Launch Vehicle-class systems: Pro-1 *vided*, That the award shall be made to the provider that 2 3 offers the best value to the government: *Provided further*, 4 That notwithstanding any other provision of law, award 5 may be made to a launch service provider competing with any certified launch vehicle in its inventory regardless of 6 7 the country of origin of the rocket engine that will be used 8 on its launch vehicle, in order to ensure robust competition 9 and continued assured access to space.

10 SEC. 8049. In addition to the amounts appropriated or otherwise made available elsewhere in this Act, 11 \$44,000,000 is hereby appropriated to the Department of 12 13 Defense: *Provided*, That upon the determination of the Secretary of Defense that it shall serve the national inter-14 15 est, the Secretary shall make grants in the amounts specified as follows: \$20,000,000 to the United Service Organi-16 zations and \$24,000,000 to the Red Cross. 17

18 SEC. 8050. None of the funds in this Act may be 19 used to purchase any supercomputer which is not manu-20 factured in the United States, unless the Secretary of De-21 fense certifies to the congressional defense committees 22 that such an acquisition must be made in order to acquire 23 capability for national security purposes that is not avail-24 able from United States manufacturers.
