Procures 4 aircraft, kits and associated installs for 10 aircraft and 4 spare engine

#### Facilities, Sustainment, Restoration, & Modernization (\$397M)

■ Funds Restoration and Modernization at 1.82% of Plant Replacement Value versus 1.69%

#### **Munitions – Small Diameter Bomb II (\$276M)**

Funding eliminates DMS and material shortages for weapon procurement

#### F-35 Procurement (\$921M)

Restores 7 Lot 17 F-35A aircraft (Block 4 capability with APG-85 radar), bringing the total FY23 procurement amount to 40
