1	People	Dual Status Technician Pay	Dual Status Military Technicians are a key component of the ARNG ability to train and build readiness for the War Fight. MILTECH and Title 5 personnel are foundational to ARNG readiness, responsible for organizing, administering, instructing, and training Soldiers, as well as maintaining equipment for all ARNG units. This ensures ready equipment and forces to defend the homeland and achieve peace through strength. Actual civilian costs currently exceed programmed CEAC rates. Current funding levels support only 94% of the authorized requirement of 25,896 Full-Time Equivalents (FTEs) for Title 5 Civilian and MILTECH positions. Additionally, we are exceeding budget in the highest Salary Grade (SAG) levels in an effort to maintain a quality workforce. This funding shortfall negatively impacts the Adjutant General's ability to provide trained Soldiers for the ARNGs dual role as the primary combat reserve of the Army and support to the state Governors for support to civil authorities.	\$ 203.00	2065A

The 92% threshold covers all ANG aircraft and engine induction requirements. Requirements for software and weapons integration to support standup of ANG F-35 CTF at Eglin AFB. Additionally provides 2x primary aircraft authorization (PAA) to Kingsley Field, OR. AETC/ANG already have agreement to support near-term Det awaiting EIS completion with Luke AFB F-35 tails.
